

Father Allouez Catholic School Tuition 2017 – 2018 Agreement

Early Childhood Families

The following tuition agreement is in effect for the 2017-2018 school year for early childhood families. Families accepted this agreement as part of the GRACE TADS registration process.

1. SCRIP Purchase Agreement

Each family is required to generate \$50.00 in profit by May 1, 2018, or pay the balance due to the school by May 15, 2017. Families can purchase scrip at either the St. Matthew or Resurrection campus/parish (or both), and the total profit will count towards the requirement.

Families can opt out of purchasing SCRIP and will be responsible to pay \$50.00 to the school by November 15, 2017.

Once a family has met the SCRIP requirement of \$50.00 in profit for the school, 50% of any additional profit will be applied toward their Father Allouez Catholic School GRACE tuition for 2018 – 2019. No refunds will be provided for families not returning to Father Allouez Catholic School.

2. Site Fundraising Agreement

Each family is encouraged to support the school's fundraising events.

3. Service Hour Agreement

Each family will work a minimum of 5 hours volunteering in ways that support the school including fundraising events, lunch duty, coaching, and school events by May 15, 2018.

Families will be billed \$15/hour for all hours not worked by May 15, 2018.

Families can opt out of volunteer hours and will be responsible to pay \$75 to the school by November 15, 2017.

Questions regarding service hour eligibility of a certain program, service or activity should be directed to the Site Advisory Council (SAC) or school office. Grandparents or other family members who are *Virtus* approved may volunteer and those hours will be counted towards the service hour agreement as reported to the school office.

If a family fails to meet the terms of this agreement, or make other arrangements with SAC, the child may not be allowed to participate in athletics, school special events, extracurricular activities, and graduation until the obligation has been met.

Please contact your school SAC or the Principal for any questions concerning this information. The SAC may exempt families or reduce requirements due to extenuating circumstances.
